Chapter 15: How to make accurate observation

When studying the Bible, observation is an important key that is often overlooked. Some Christians lack of observation in Bible study is caused by the lack of time spent reading the Bible. When taking the time to read the word it is best not to look at devotional books, though they contain spiritual value there is no observation required. It is best to study the word when there is little to no distractions so you can focus on the meaning behind the passage instead of just reading the words their self. Reading a Bible that you can understand the language, using different translations for comparison, and reading slower or aloud is helpful techniques. Chapter 16: How to use Multiple translations of the Bible.

The use of different translations of the Bible can be useful especially when trying to understand the content in the passage. There are several different translations, NIV, NASB, CSB, and NKJ are just a few in circulation. Each translation is agreed upon by a committee who determines the best way to translate the text to English. When observing, passages in different translation Bibles keep it simple, look for alike or unique words, use three to five translation Bible, make sure that you are using both formal and functional translations, use a base text as the standard for comparing the different translations, and the use of color coding can make for easy reference when used to highlight unique or base texts. Chapter 17: How to ask questions

There are no key observation questions we must ask when studying the Bible. When we ask who, we are looking for key people the passage is talking about. Asking what will give us an understanding as to what is taking place. When we ask where we are looking for the geographical location which is important because knowing the "where" will help you understand the "what". "When" will aid in knowing the element of time of when the events in the passage was written. The question "why" can help in both observation and interpretation, we ask why something was written, done, or said. The question "how" is used to consider the questions of in what way or by what means. (Cartwright & Hulshof, 2019, Everyday Bible Study Second Edition, p.90-93)

Chapter 18: How to find the meaning of the Bible

Through the processes of observation, interpretation, correlation, and application we can understand the meaning behind the verses we read in the Bible. Observation has been established as the first step in this process to determine what we see in the word. Secondly, we must interpret what we have seen or find what the text meant in that passage. correlation follows with answering the questions of how this meaning fit into the rest of the Bible. After we find how the meaning fits into the rest of the Bible, we have to use what we have learned and apply it to our life. If we follow this process, we will be able to understand and apply God's word to our life. (Cartwright & Hulshof, 2019, Everyday Bible Study Second Edition, p.90-93)
