Each breeding of tea cup puppies has its own definition of what size a tea cup poodle should be! Most tea mugs breeders agree that a cup of Poodle tea should be 4 pounds and below. But since poodles are measured by height and not weight, this should to be a factor. Most tea cup poodle breeders also agree that a tcup poodle should be under 8 inches.
